In one specific instance, the resident thought she was only feeding 11 cats, but it turned out to be over 25! Altering is a critical step to eliminating cat overpopulation, however, it can quickly become costly. Last year's Winter Snow Ball donations went toward the spay/neuter costs associated with this colony! *We can't thank you enough for your continued support and generosity!!!*

## **About S.T.A.R.T.**

**S.T.A.R.T., Save the Animals Rescue Team**, is a non-profit humane organization, founded by Annette Lamberti that rescues stray, abandoned, injured, and abused kittens and cats. The rescued animals are examined by a veterinarian, spayed and neutered, vaccinated, and placed in one of our volunteer foster homes. Since S.T.A.R.T. does not have a shelter facility, these animals remain in our foster care until they are adopted. So many of these unfortunate animals are victims of pet overpopulation, therefore, this life-saving work is **critical!!**

An important part of our rescue work is to maintain sterile colonies of cats. Sterile colonies are colonies where Trap, Neuter, Return (TNR) has been implemented. TNR is a humane way of helping to decrease overpopulation. Feeding and care for these colonies can begin as early as 5:00 a.m. for some of our volunteers. Colonies are fed everyday, no matter what the weather, and, when needed, medical care is given.

In addition, S.T.A.R.T. participates in an outreach program with various shelters and rescue groups. We rescue animals before they are euthanized, giving them a second chance at life.

S.T.A.R.T. operates with and relies solely on private contributions, member financial support, and fundraisers to carry out all of these vital efforts.
